

ORDINANCE NO. 124

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 112;
TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 24; AND TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goshen adopted Ordinance 24 on November 12, 2002 and thereby created certain procedures regarding the proceedings of the City Council of the City of Goshen; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goshen approved Ordinance No. 112 on June 10, 2014, which amended Ordinance No. 24 and repealed Ordinance No. 103; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public places within the City where the ordinances are posted should be changed due to the closing of the School House Café which had been designated as one of the five and that this fact alone constitutes an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOSHEN, ARKANSAS:


SECTION 1. That Ordinance 112 is hereby repealed in its entirety and Ordinance 24 is amended to delete Section 3 and that the following language shall be substituted as Section 3 of Ordinance 24:

Section 3. That, in accordance with state law, ordinances of the City of Goshen, once adopted, shall be posted in the five most public places within the City, which places are City Hall, Community Building, Fast Trax, Convenience Store operated by Anderson's Gas & Propane, Inc., and the Post Office, which posting shall constitute publication of ordinances as provided in Ark. Code Ann. §14-55-206(a)(1)(B). The City Recorder shall compose the agenda of regular meeting of the City Council and cause it to be posted where the City posts ordinances after their adoption. Posting of the agenda shall be done no later than 5 p.m. Thursday preceding the regular meeting on the following Tuesday.

SECTION 2. The intended effect of this ordinance is to change the public places within the City where the ordinances are posted. Except as amended hereby, in all other respects, Ordinance 24 is ratified and reaffirmed.

SECTION 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: Because of the closing of the School House Café, these matters are such pressing business that it is viewed that an immediate solution is necessary thereby creating an emergency. It is hereby declared that based on the conditions set forth herein, an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Goshen, Arkansas, shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.
