

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE
OFFICE OF CITY MARSHAL IN THE CITY
OF GOSHEN AS AN APPOINTIVE OFFICE;
ESTABLISHING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT THEREOF;
PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT THEREOF; AND
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City of Goshen is a city of the second class; and

WHEREAS, the City of Goshen is presently without a City Marshal since no one chose to run for the position; and

WHEREAS, Ark. Code Ann. §14-44-111 provides that the office of City Marshal may be filled by appointment upon passage of an ordinance to that effect; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the best interests of the City to fill said office by appointment and permit the City Marshal to reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Goshen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSHEN:

SECTION 1. The office of City Marshal is hereby established as an appointive office..

SECTION 2. Said office shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §14-44-111. Pursuant to said statute, the City Marshal shall be appointed or removed by the Mayor unless the City Council shall, by two-thirds (2/3) majority of the total membership of the Council, vote to override the mayor's action.


SECTION 3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §14-44-110, the City Marshal shall be permitted to reside outside the corporate limits of the City of Goshen.

SECTION 4. The duties of said marshal shall be those as set in Ark. Code Ann. § 14-44-113 and such other duties as provided by state law or as shall be prescribed by ordinance, consistent with the provisions of state law. The compensation of the City Marshal shall be set by the City Council.

SECTION 5. **EMERGENCY CLAUSE:** It is hereby declared that based on the conditions set forth herein, an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Goshen, Arkansas, shall

be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.
