## **ORDINANCE NO. 74**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 46 ADOPTED JUNE 8, 2004 WHICH WAS AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FIREWORKS; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goshen adopted Ordinance No. 46 on June 8, 2004 and thereby regulated the sale and use of fireworks within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend and restate the current Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOSHEN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to sell fireworks within the City limits of said City. Fireworks shall be defined as defined in Ark. Code Ann. 20-22-701 et seq., including any amendments enacted with respect thereto.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to discharge, explode or ignite any fireworks within the City limits except the following dates: July 1-5. During that time period when it is lawful to discharge fireworks, no fireworks shall be discharged after 11:00 P.M. or before 10:00 A.M.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful to discharge, explode or ignite fireworks within six hundred feet (600') of any church. No person shall ignite or discharge any fireworks within, or throw the fireworks from, a motor vehicle while therein, nor shall any person place or throw any ignited article of fireworks into or at a motor vehicle or at or near any person or group of people. It shall be unlawful to discharge fireworks on private property without written permission from the owner. No fireworks, debris, or fallout from such fireworks shall be permitted on public property or on the property of others.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful to discharge, explode or ignite fireworks within fifty feet (50')of an adjoining property owner.

SECTION 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200) or imprisoned for not more than ninety (90) days, or both, in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 6. Ordinance 46 adopted June 8, 2004, is hereby repealed.
